On August 1st, 2013, I underwent a 12 hour surgery to remove the tumor, 3 ribs, and part of my spine. I spent 1/3 of last year in the hospital. I know I had over a billion prayers said for me and they were answered on March 4th, 2014 when I was told I was "Cancer Free".

I am now working hard to regain my strength so I will be able to participate in Volleyball, Basketball, Track, and Fast Pitch Softball next year at Sanborn Central High School where I will be a Sophomore.
